(Authorization for operating a facility for Collection, Generation, Reception, Storage of Biomedical Wastes)

- 1 Authorization Letter No. BMW/2018-2019/Alwar/BMW/41.
- 2 **Mr Rajan Kumar Shukla, Site Head of Shree Jee Laboratory Pvt Ltd is hereby granted an authorization under Rule 10 of Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2016 (BMW Rules,2016) to operate a facility for Collection, Generation, Reception, Storage of biomedical waste on the premisses situated at C-24 & 25, RIICO Industrial Area, Sotanala Behror, Alwar, Behror, Tehsil Alwar, District Alwar.**
- 3 This authorization is valid till it is cancelled /revoked by the Competent Authority.
- 4 This authorization is valid for operation of the Laboratory with 0 (zero) number of beds.
- 5 This authorization is subject to the conditions contained in enclosed annexure and to such other conditions/guidlines as may be specified under BMW Rules, 2016 by Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi or Ministry of Environment & Forests(MoEF), Government of India (GOI) or Department of Environment (DOE), Government of Rajasthan (GOR).
- 6 Segregation, packing, transportation, storage, treatment & disposal of bio medical waste shall be in accordance with Rule 7 & 8 of BMW Rules, 2016. The bio medical waste shall be disposed of at Common Biomedical Waste Treatment & Disposal Facility (CBMWTF) established for the area viz Hoswin Incinerator, MIA, Alwar.
- 7 The mercury bearing waste arising due to breakage of thermometers,pressure gauges and other instruments is not to be treated as bio-medical waste or other solid waste.The mercury bearing waste is to be segregated, collected , stored and disposed in accordance with the provisions of Hazardous Waste and other wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 8 The Annual report in accordance with Rule 13 for the period 1st January to 31st December of previous year shall be submitted On or before 30th June of every year in form - IV as prescribed in the Rules and the annual report shall also be made available on the web-site of the occupier. Further, all the health care facilities shall develop their website within two years from the date of notification of the BMW Rules,2016, in case not already developed.

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- 9 The hospital shall maintain the record of biomedical waste as per Rule 14 & shall be produced during the inspection.
- 10 That the hospital shall phase out use of chlorinated plastic bags, gloves and blood bags within two years from the date of notification of the BMW Rules, 2016.
- 11 That the hospital shall establish a Bar-Code System for bags or containers containing bio-medical waste to be sent out of the premises or place for any purpose within one years from the date of the notification of the BMW Rules, 2016.
- 12 That the hospital shall provide training to all its health care workers and others, involved in handing of bio-medical waste at the time of induction and thereafter at least once every year and the details of training programs conducted, number of personnel trained and number of personnel not undergone any training shall be provided in the Annual Report.
- 13 In case of expansion in bed capacity or increase in pollution load, the hospital shall obtain prior Consent to Establish under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 & revised Authorization under BMW Rules, 2016.
- 14 That the hospital shall comply the provisions of Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 15 That the hospital shall comply with the standards for treatment disposal of Boi-medical Waste as specified under schedule II of Boi-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 16 That infected hospital liquied waste must be given chemical treatment by using at least 10% hypochlorite solution or any other equivalent chemical reagent to ensure required disinfection as prescribed in part-2 of schedule-I of the Rules.



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- 17 That this consent/authorization is valid for Microbiology lab. & Occupational health center @ 1 no. only.
- 18 That the hospital management shall continue to segregate the bio medical waste as per provisions of BMWR-2016, as amended till date, and hand it over regularly to operator of common Bio Medical waste disposal facility, after due packing in colour coded bags, as prescribed in schedule IV (Rule-6) of the BMWR-2016.
- 19 That the hospital shall install adequate fire protection equipment (such as smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, sand bucket, fire alarm, Water sprinklers etc.) at salient places with in the premises of the hospital, even at bio-medical storage area, in accordance with the fire safety regulations and to submit certificate of the competent authority in this respect to this office within one month.
- 20 That the hospital management shall dispose Biomedical Waste as per BMW Rules, i.e through CBMWTDF.
- 21 That this authorization is subjected to post audit of Pollution Control Measures (PCM) and consent conditions. In case, it is found during post inspection, the industry has flouted conditions of consent/ authorization/ or inadequate PCM, the authorization will be revoked and directions for closure will be issued under 33 (A) of water Act,1974, section 31 (A) of Air Act,1981 & BMWR-2016 or section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986 without any further notice.
- 22 That the hospital shall maintain record of collection, storage and transportation of bio-medical waste to Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facility (CBWTDF) for disposal. The quarterly abstract related to the collection, storage, transportation and disposal shall be submitted to the H.O. and Regional Office in the format given below:
